1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Small Pond Exemptions - Height Measurement**

3 FOR the purpose of modifying the height measurement criteria of dams eligible for a
4 certain exemption from a certain permit.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
6 Article - Environment
7 Section 5-503(b)
8 Annotated Code of Maryland
9 (1993 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article - Environment**

13 5-503.

14 (b) (1) A person is exempt from the requirement of obtaining a permit from the
15 Department if:

16 (i) The plans and specifications are approved by the appropriate soil
17 conservation district;

18 (ii) The pond is not located within drainage of the GwynnsFalls, Jones
19 Falls, or Herring Run streams situated in or adjacent to Baltimore City;

20 (iii) The pond meets minimum standards for safety set forth in
21 Department rules and regulations;

22 (iv) The contributory drainage area is less than 1 square mile (640
23 acres);

24 (v) The dam is not greater than 20 feet in height measured vertically
25 from the lowest point on the top of the dam to the lowest point on the [downstream]
26 UPSTREAM toe of the dam;

27 (vi) The pond is a low hazard structure the failure of which is unlikely
28 to cause loss of life or property damage; and

1 (vii) The pond is not a wastewater stabilization pond.

2 (2) The soil conservation district shall notify the Department of any pond
3 approved under this subsection. Nothing in this subsection is a limitation on the
4 Department's authority under this subtitle.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 1996.
