A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Property Insurance Availability Act - Extension of TerminationDate**

3 FOR the purpose of extending the termination date of the Maryland Property Insurance  
4 Availability Act; and providing for the future codification of certain provisions of  
5 this Act.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 48A - Insurance Code**

21 478-I.

22 This subtitle shall no longer be of any force after [June 30, 1996] OCTOBER 1, 2004;  
23 except that obligations incurred by the Association established pursuant to the provisions  
24 of this subtitle shall not be impaired by the expiration of this subtitle and such  
25 Association shall be continued for the purpose of performing such obligations.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland  
27 read as follows:

1                   **Article - Insurance**

2 25-411.

3                   (a) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, this subtitle shall terminate on [June  
4 30, 1996] OCTOBER 1, 2004.

5                   (b) Obligations that the Association incurred under this subtitle are not impaired  
6 by the expiration of this subtitle and the Association shall continue for the purpose of  
7 performing the obligations.

8                   SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall  
9 take effect June 30, 1996.

10                  SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall  
11 take effect October 1, 1997.
