13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (a) A member OF THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM may retire with a18 normal service retirement allowance if:
