- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (a) (1) Unless it is renewed for another term, a facility permit expires on the
- 17 expiration date the Department specifies at issuance or renewal.
- 18 (2) Unless the controlled hazardous substance facility is a low-level nuclear
- 19 waste facility, the Department may not issue a facility permit for a term longer than [3]
- $20\ \ 10$ years. The Department may issue a low-level nuclear waste facility permit for a term
- 21 not longer than 5 years.
- 22 (b) The Department may renew a facility permit if the permit holder:
- 23 (1) Has complied with all appropriate rules and regulations;
- 24 (2) Pays to the Department the renewal fee set by the Department; and
- 25 (3) Submits to the Department a renewal application on the formthe
