13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:14 **Article - Environment**

16 (a) (1) Unless it is renewed for another term, a facility permit expires on the
17 expiration date the Department specifies at issuance or renewal.18 (2) Unless the controlled hazardous substance facility is a low-level nuclear
19 waste facility, the Department may not issue a facility permit for a term longer than [3]
20 10 years. The Department may issue a low-level nuclear waste facility permit for a term
21 not longer than 5 years.

22 (b) The Department may renew a facility permit if the permit holder:

1 (1) Has complied with all appropriate rules and regulations;

2 (2) Pays to the Department the renewal fee set by the Department; and

3 (3) Submits to the Department a renewal application on the form the

4 Department requires.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

6 October 1, 1996.
