CHAPTER ____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Charles County - Thomas Stone National Historic Site

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$250,000,
- 4 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the National Park Service for certain
- 5 acquisition, development, or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of
- 6 the loan proceeds; and providing generally for the issuance and saleof bonds
- 7 evidencing the loan.
- 8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 9 MARYLAND, That:
- 10 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 11 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Charles County
- 12 Thomas Stone National Historic Site Loan of 1996 in the total principal amount of
- 13 \$250,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general
- 14 obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued,
- 15 sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 16 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 17 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan maybe sold as a
- 18 single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under §
- 19 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 20 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and
- 21 first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the
- 22 bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on
- 23 the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works,
- 24 for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects'and engineers' fees:
- 25 as a grant to the National Park Service for the planning, design, construction, and

- 1 equipping capital equipping of a visitor contact station at Thomas Stone National Historic 2 Site in Charles County.
- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate 4 and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bondsas and when due 5 and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of 6 issuance of the bonds.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 June 1, 1996.
