A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Charles County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Golf Courses)**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting in Charles County the sale or consumption of alcoholic
5 beverages in publicly owned golf courses and grounds; making the violation of these
6 provisions subject to certain penalties; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages
7 in Charles County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 8-503.

17 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CHARLES COUNTY.

18 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR CONSUME ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON ANY
19 PUBLICLY OWNED GOLF COURSE OR GROUNDS.

20 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT
21 TO THE PENALTIES SET FORTH IN § 16-503 OF THIS ARTICLE.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 1996.
