1 AN ACT concerning

2 Vehicle Laws - Operation of Sound Amplification System - Noise Prohibition

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the driver of a motor vehicle from operating, or
- 4 permitting the operation of, a sound amplification system in a certain manner while
- 5 the vehicle is on a highway; prohibiting the owner, operator, or other person
- 6 entrusted with a motor vehicle by the owner or operator, from operating, or
- 7 permitting the operation of, a sound amplification system in a certain manner while
- 8 the vehicle is parked; specifying certain exceptions to the prohibition; defining a
- 9 certain term; and generally relating to a prohibition on the operation of a sound
- amplification system from a motor vehicle in a certain manner.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 23 Article Transportation
- 24 21-1121.
- 25 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "SOUND AMPLIFICATION SYSTEM" MEANS A COMPACT
- 26 DISC PLAYER, A RADIO, A TAPE PLAYER, OR A SIMILAR DEVICE.
- 27 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:
- 28 (1) AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY VEHICLES;

- 1 (2) VEHICLES OPERATED BY COMMUNICATIONS, ELECTRIC, GAS, OR 2 WATER UTILITIES:
- 3 (3) A SOUND AMPLIFICATION SYSTEM OPERATED TO REQUEST 4 ASSISTANCE OR TO WARN OF A HAZARDOUS SITUATION; OR
- 5 (4) UNLESS OTHERWISE PROHIBITED BY LOCAL LAW, A SOUND 6 AMPLIFICATION SYSTEM USED FOR ADVERTISING, PARADES, OR FOR POLITICAL OR
- 7 OTHER SPECIAL EVENTS.
- 8 (C) WHEN A MOTOR VEHICLE IS BEING OPERATED ON A HIGHWAY, THE
- 9 DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE MAY NOT OPERATE, OR PERMIT THE OPERATION OF, A
- 10 SOUND AMPLIFICATION SYSTEM FROM THE VEHICLE THAT PRODUCES A NOISE
- 11 LEVEL THAT EXCEEDS 75 DBA IN ANY AREA THAT IS 50 FEET OR MORE OUTSIDE THE
- 12 VEHICLE.
- 13 (D) WHEN A MOTOR VEHICLE IS PARKED, THE OWNER, OPERATOR, OR
- 14 OTHER PERSON ENTRUSTED WITH THE VEHICLE BY THE OWNER OR OPERATOR,
- 15 MAY NOT OPERATE OR PERMIT THE OPERATION OF A SOUND AMPLIFICATION
- 16 SYSTEM FROM THE VEHICLE THAT PRODUCES A NOISE LEVEL THAT EXCEEDS 70
- 17 DBA IN ANY AREA THAT IS 50 FEET OR MORE OUTSIDE THE VEHICLE.

- 19 (a) It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the provisions of the
- 20 Maryland Vehicle Law unless the violation is declared to be a felony bythe Maryland
- 21 Vehicle Law or by any other law of this State.
- 22 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any person convicted of a
- 23 misdemeanor for the violation of any of the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law is
- 24 subject to a fine of not more than \$500.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 1996.
