1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program - Enhanced Testing - Indefinite Prohibition

- 3 FOR the purpose of extending indefinitely the prohibition on requiring a certain motor
- 4 vehicle being tested under the Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program to undergo
- 5 transient mass-emission testing, evaporative system integrity testing, a test that
- 6 requires the removal of the driver from the vehicle being tested, oron-road testing;
- 7 providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relatingto enhanced
- 8 testing and testing procedures under the Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (d) (1) Notwithstanding subsection (c)(6) of this section or any other provision
- 19 of law, [during the period from January 1, 1995 through May 31, 1996,] the emissions
- 20 control program established under this subtitle may not require for anyvehicle other than
- 21 a State-owned vehicle or, to the extent authorized by federal law, a federally-owned
- 22 vehicle:
- 23 (i) Transient mass-emission testing using the IM 240 driving cycle
- 24 referenced under 40 C.F.R. Part 51;
- 25 (ii) An evaporative system integrity (pressure) test or anevaporative
- 26 system transient purge test that requires the disconnection or manipulation of any engine
- 27 component, including any hose or emissions equipment, that is located in the vehicle's
- 28 engine compartment;

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1	(iii) Removal of the driver from a vehicle being tested orinspected; or
2	(iv) On-road testing.
	(2) Nothing in this subsection prohibits the emissions control program from offering to vehicle owners, on a voluntary basis, any of the tests and inspections described in paragraph (1) of this subsection.
6 7	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1996.
