- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 22 (a) (7) IN GARRETT COUNTY, SUNDAY SALES ARE GOVERNED BY § 11-512
- 23 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (b) (5) (I) THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY IN [In] Garrett County[, 24
- 25 however, Sunday sales when].
- 26 (II) WHEN New Year's Eve or New Year's Day fall on a Sunday, SALES
- 27 shall be governed by § 11-402(j) of this article.

(III) PROVISIONS FOR SUNDAY SALES FOR CLASS B AND C 2 LICENSEES ARE GOVERNED BY § 11-512 OF THIS ARTICLE. 3 11-512. 4 (A) [In] THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN Garrett County[, notwithstanding]. 5 (B) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING any other provisions of this subtitle and except on 6 Sundays and New Year's Day, holders of any class of on- or off-sale licenses issued under 7 this article[, including a holder of a Class E steamboat license issuedby the State 8 Comptroller's Office for use on all State waters located within GarrettCounty,] may sell 9 the alcoholic beverages authorized under their respective license from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the 10 following day, but may not sell alcoholic beverages between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. 11 on any day of the week or, UNLESS AUTHORIZED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS 12 SECTION, at any time on Sunday after 2 a.m. 13 (2) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION APPLY TO A HOLDER OF A 14 CLASS E STEAMBOAT LICENSE ISSUED BY THE STATE COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE FOR 15 USE ON ALL STATE WATERS LOCATED WITHIN THE COUNTY. 16 (3) However, this section is subject to the provisions of § 11-402(j) of this 17 article regarding sales on New Year's Eve or New Year's Day regardless of the day of the 18 week on which December 31 and January 1 fall. (C) (1) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION APPLY ONLY IN THOSE 19 20 ELECTION DISTRICTS WHICH AUTHORIZE THEM. (2) THIS SUBSECTION ONLY APPLIES TO ON-PREMISES SALES BY 21 22 HOLDERS OF CLASS C SERVICE CLUB LICENSES AND, SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (4) OF 23 THIS SUBSECTION, HOLDERS OF CLASS B LICENSES. (3) SUNDAY SALES MAY BEGIN, WHERE PERMITTED, AT 1 P.M. AND 24 25 CONTINUE UNTIL 10 P.M. (4) (I) THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS 26 27 C SERVICE CLUB LICENSE. 28 (II) SUNDAY SALES MAY BE MADE ONLY WHEN THE CONSUMER 29 PLACES AN ORDER FOR A MEAL SIMULTANEOUSLY OR PRIOR TO PLACING AN 30 ORDER FOR AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE OR THE CONSUMER IS OTHERWISE 31 ENTITLED TO A MEAL ON THE PREMISES AS PART OF A PREARRANGED EVENT, SUCH 32 AS A BANOUET, WHERE THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE IS SERVED, BAR OR COUNTER 33 SALES MAY BE MADE AS LONG AS THE CONSUMER COMPLIES WITH THE 34 REQUIREMENT OF THIS PARAGRAPH. 35 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That before this Act becomes 36 effective it shall first be submitted to a referendum of the legally qualified voters of each 37 election district in Garrett County at the general election to be held in November, 1996. 38 The Board of County Commissioners and the Board of Supervisors of Elections of

39 Garrett County shall do those things necessary and proper to provide for and hold the 40 referendum required by this section. If a majority of the votes cast ineach election district 41 on the question are "For the referred law" the provisions of this Act shall become

- 1 effective in those election districts on December 14, 1996, but if a majority of the votes
- 2 cast in a particular election district on the question are "Against thereferred law" the
- 3 provisions of this Act are of no effect and null and void in that election district.
- 4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions
- 5 of Section 2 of this Act and for the sole purpose of providing for the referendum required
- 6 by Section 2, this Act shall take effect July 1, 1996.
