BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions** 15 17-511. 16 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated. 17 (2) "Business" means a person or entity, regardless of legal structure, 18 through which real estate brokerage services are provided. 19 (3) "Interest in a business" means, in the case of a business that is in a 20 corporation, the outstanding voting stock of the corporation through which real estate 21 brokerage services are provided. 22 (b) (1) Not more than 49% of the interest in a business may be held directly or 23 indirectly by associate real estate brokers, real estate salespersons, or any combination of 24 associate brokers or salespersons.

(2) An interest of a licensee in a business through which real estate

26 brokerage services are provided shall include any interest in the business held by an

27 immediate family member of the licensee.

- 1 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, 50% OF 2 THE INTEREST IN A BUSINESS MAY BE HELD BY A SINGLE ASSOCIATE REAL ESTATE 3 BROKER OR BY A SINGLE REAL ESTATE SALESPERSON.
- 4 (c) Except as to the limitation of interest of the professional service corporation
- 5 in a business through which real estate brokerage services are provided, this section does
- 6 not affect the formation of a professional service corporation by associate real estate
- 7 brokers and real estate salespersons authorized by § 17-512 of this subtitle.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 October 1, 1996.
