14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(b) (1) The Commission may [not] authorize telephone company chargesto be
[levied] EXCLUDED for directory assistance calls made by residential customers [upon
the first 6] A FIXED NUMBER OF calls made to directory assistance from each residential

- 22 (2) In order to determine just and reasonable rates for residential telephone
- 23 service, the Commission [shall] MAY adjust the residential telephone rates of a
- 24 telephone company that it considers appropriate to provide the same netoperating
- 25 income that the telephone company would realize if [no] charges were [levied on the
- 26 first 12] EXCLUDED FOR A FIXED NUMBER OF calls made to directory assistance
- 27 [under paragraph (1) of this subsection].
- (3) The Commission may not authorize telephone company charges to be
 levied for directory assistance upon any person who suffers from a physical or visual
 handicap that precludes the use of a telephone directory.

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1 (4) The Commission may provide other exemptions that are just and 2 reasonable.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect4 October 1, 1996.
