BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 19 Article 88A - Social Services Administration 20 14.

(a) (1) The local department in each county shall have a board, appointed as

22 hereinafter provided and herein referred to as the local board. The local board shall be 23 composed of eight members until June 30, 1968 and of nine members thereafter. The

- 1 members shall receive no salary for their services, but their reasonable expenses incurred
- 2 in attending meetings or performing other official duties shall be paid. Each local board
- 3 shall select its own chairman on July 1st of each year.
- 4 (d) Any member of any of the local boards who shall fail to attend at least fifty

- 16 vacancy exists on the local board and proceed to have it filled by appointment for the
- 17 remainder of the unexpired term in the manner provided in [the aforegoing] subsection
