- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article 33 - Election Code
- 15 27-1.
- (C) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS REGISTERED TO VOTE BY MAIL MAY NOT VOTE 16
- 17 BY ABSENTEE BALLOT UNTIL THE INDIVIDUAL HAS VOTED AT LEAST ONCE,
- 18 SUBSEOUENT TO THAT REGISTRATION. IN PERSON AT A POLLING PLACE OR HAS
- 19 APPLIED IN PERSON AT THE OFFICE OF THE BOARD FOR AN EMERGENCY ABSENTEE
- 20 BALLOT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21
- 22 October 1, 1996.
