A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County - Maryland School for the Deaf - Bus Service**

3 **MC 612-96**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring that, under certain circumstances, the Montgomery County  
5 Board of Education provide daily school bus service for students of the Maryland  
6 School for the Deaf who are Montgomery County residents.

7 BY adding to

9 Section 8-313

10 Annotated Code of Maryland

11 (1992 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Education**

15 8-313.

16 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE  
17 MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL PROVIDE DAILY SCHOOL  
18 BUS SERVICE FOR STUDENTS OF THE MARYLAND SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF WHO ARE  
19 MONTGOMERY COUNTY RESIDENTS.

20 (B) THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION IS NOT REQUIRED  
21 TO PROVIDE DAILY SCHOOL BUS SERVICE FOR A STUDENT UNDER THIS SECTION IF  
22 THE TRIP TO OR FROM THE SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF IS LONGER THAN ONE AND  
23 ONE-HALF HOURS OR OVER A DISTANCE OF MORE THAN 65 MILES, WHICHEVER  
24 TAKES A SHORTER PERIOD OF TIME.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
26 October 1, 1996.
