- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Education
- 15 8-313.
- 16 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE
- 17 MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL PROVIDE DAILY SCHOOL
- 18 BUS SERVICE FOR STUDENTS OF THE MARYLAND SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF WHO ARE
- 19 MONTGOMERY COUNTY RESIDENTS.
- 20 (B) THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION IS NOT REQUIRED
- 21 TO PROVIDE DAILY SCHOOL BUS SERVICE FOR A STUDENT UNDER THIS SECTION IF
- 22 THE TRIP TO OR FROM THE SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF IS LONGER THAN ONE AND
- 23 ONE-HALF HOURS OR OVER A DISTANCE OF MORE THAN 65 MILES, WHICHEVER
- 24 TAKES A SHORTER PERIOD OF TIME.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 1996.
