## 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 15 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

17 (e) The license may not be issued to, or for use in conjunction with, or upon the

18 premises of any restaurant located within a drugstore [or billiard hall] or for use upon

19 any premises which has a door, archway, opening or other passageway providing direct

20 public access to any [billiard hall or] drugstore.

2 (c) (1) (I) This [subsection] PARAGRAPH applies only in Anne Arundel 3 [and Montgomery Counties] COUNTY.

4 [(2)] (II) A license may not be issued to, or for use in conjunction with, or 5 upon the premises of any restaurant located within a bowling alley, drugstore or billiard 6 hall or for use upon any premises which has a door, archway, opening orother passageway 7 providing direct public access to any bowling alley, billiard hall or drugstore.

8 (2) (I) THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

9 (II) A LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED TO, OR FOR USE IN
10 CONJUNCTION WITH, OR UPON THE PREMISES OF ANY RESTAURANT LOCATED
11 WITHIN A BOWLING ALLEY OR DRUGSTORE OR FOR USE UPON ANY PREMISES
12 WHICH HAS A DOOR, ARCHWAY, OPENING OR OTHER PASSAGEWAY PROVIDING
13 DIRECT PUBLIC ACCESS TO ANY BOWLING ALLEY OR DRUGSTORE.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 October 1, 1996.
