SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

(a) A police officer may arrest without a warrant any person who commits, or
attempts to commit, any felony or misdemeanor in the presence of, or within the view of,
such officer.

(b) A police officer who has probable cause to believe that a felonyormisdemeanor is being committed in the officer's presence or within the officer's view, may

20 arrest without a warrant any person whom the officer may reasonably believe to have 21 committed such offense.

(g) For purposes of this section, the term "police officer" means any person who,in an official capacity, is authorized by law to make arrests and who is:
