CHAPTER \_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission - Prince George's**

3 **County - Personnel**

4 **PG/MC 27-96**

5 FOR the purpose of providing that, in Prince George's County, deputy directors and  
6 comparable positions under the Prince George's County Planning Board shall meet  
7 certain requirements and receive compensation in accordance with the Planning  
8 Board's budget; providing that certain individuals are appointed by and serve at the  
9 pleasure of the Planning Board; permitting individuals serving as deputy directors  
10 on a certain date to elect to remain in the merit system; and generally relating to  
11 certain managerial positions under the Prince George's County Planning Board.

12 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
13 Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission  
14 Section 7-111(c)  
15 Annotated Code of Maryland  
16 (1993 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**1 Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission**

2 7-111.

3 (c) (1) Each planning board shall have administrative control and jurisdiction  
4 over personnel performing the duties and functions assigned in this section to the  
5 respective planning boards.

6 (2) (i) IN THIS PARAGRAPH, "DEPUTY DIRECTOR" INCLUDES ANY  
7 POSITION COMPARABLE TO THE POSITION OF A DEPUTY DIRECTOR, AS  
8 DETERMINED BY THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY PLANNING BOARD.

9 (II) In Prince George's County, a director OR DEPUTY DIRECTOR of a  
10 department shall have education or professional experience in a field relevant to the  
11 responsibilities of that department.

12 [(ii)] (III) A director OR DEPUTY DIRECTOR shall receive the  
13 compensation established in the budget for the Prince George's County planning board.

14 [(iii)] (IV) 1. Except as provided in item 2 of this subparagraph, a  
15 director [serves] OR DEPUTY DIRECTOR SHALL BE APPOINTED BY AND SERVE at the  
16 pleasure of the Prince George's County planning board.

17 2. In Prince George's County, [a person who, on June 30, 1991,  
18 is a director of planning or a director of Parks and Recreation] AN INDIVIDUAL may  
19 elect to remain in the merit system established under § 2-112 of this article IF:

20 A. ON JUNE 30, 1991, THE INDIVIDUAL IS A DIRECTOR OF  
21 PLANNING OR A DIRECTOR OF PARKS AND RECREATION; OR

22 B. ON JUNE 30, 1996, THE INDIVIDUAL IS A DEPUTY  
23 DIRECTOR OF PLANNING OR A DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF PARKS AND RECREATION.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
25 July 1, 1996.
