12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission**

15 3-102.

16 (h) The boundaries of the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District within
17 Prince George's County are extended by the addition [thereto] of the following
18 described areas which [said areas] shall [hereafter] be integral portions of the
19 [Maryland-Washington] Metropolitan District in Prince George's County:

20 (1) All of the Queen Anne Election District (No. 7), not previously included
21 within the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District[.];

22 (2) All of the Marlboro Election District (No. 3)[.];

23 (3) All of the Melwood Election District (No. 15)[.];

24 (4) All of the Brandywine Election District (No. 11)[.];

25 (5) All of the Piscataway Election District (No. 5), not previously included
26 within the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District;

27 (6) ALL OF THE NOTTINGHAM ELECTION DISTRICT (NO. 8); AND

1 (7) ALL OF THE AQUASCO ELECTION DISTRICT (NO. 4).

2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
3 July 1, 1996.
