5 6 7 8 9	FOR the purpose of requiring the approval of the Montgomery County Council and the Prince George's County Council before a regulation proposed by the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission may be adopted; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the authority of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to adopt regulations.

15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
17	Article 29 - Washington Suburban Sanitary District
18	9-101.
21	(a) (1) Except as otherwise provided by this article, AND SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, the WSSC may adopt rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this article and any other laws the enforcement and administration of which is vested in the WSSC.
23	(2) The WSSC may:
	(i) Limit or regulate the use and supply of water service and sanitary sewer service on a temporary basis in any area or to any premises served by the WSSC's facilities, as the needs of the occasion and the protection of the WSSC's systems require;

(ii) Adopt rules and regulations not inconsistent with lawthat the

28 WSSC considers necessary for the public safety, health, comfort, or convenience in the 29 construction, operation, maintenance, expansion, relocation, replacement, renovation,

30 and repair of the WSSC's water system and sanitary sewer system; and

1	(iii) Fix the forms of permits and specify the nature, type, and amount
2	of information, detail, and engineering data that a person must submit to the WSSC for
3	any permit authorized or required by this article.

- 4 (B) (1) BEFORE THE WSSC MAY ADOPT A REGULATION, THE WSSC SHALL 5 SUBMIT THE PROPOSED REGULATION TO EACH COUNTY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL.
- 6 (2) WITHIN 30 DAYS OF RECEIVING THE PROPOSED REGULATION, EACH 7 COUNTY COUNCIL SHALL APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE THE PROPOSED REGULATION.
- 8 (3) IF EITHER COUNTY COUNCIL DISAPPROVES THE PROPOSED 9 REGULATION, THE WSSC MAY NOT ADOPT THE REGULATION.
- [(b)] (C) Except for the immediate preservation of the public healthand safety or for emergency provisions required to protect the WSSC's systems, the WSSC shall publish separate notices of any new [rules and regulations which are] REGULATION THAT IS authorized by this section at least 30 days before [their] ITS effective date in at least 1 newspaper published in each county.
- 15 [(c)] (D) Any rule or regulation adopted by the WSSC under this section has the 16 force and authority of law.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any regulations adopted by the WSSC before the effectivedate of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 1996.
