- 15 (A) A regulated lobbyist may not be engaged for lobbying purposes for
- 16 compensation that is dependent in any manner on:
- 17 (1) (i) the enactment or defeat of legislation; or
- 18 (ii) any other contingency related to legislative action; or
- 19 (2) (i) the outcome of any executive action relating to the solicitation or
- 20 securing of a procurement contract; or
- 21 (ii) any other contingency related to executive action.
- 22 (B) A REGULATED LOBBYIST MAY NOT BE ENGAGED FOR COMPENSATION AS
