A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Education - Noncertificated Public School Employees -**  
3 **Negotiations**  
4 **PG 416-96**

5 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Education of Prince George's County or its  
6 representatives to negotiate with representatives of certain employee organizations  
7 under certain circumstances on all matters that relate to the discipline or discharge  
8 of noncertificated employees; and generally relating to negotiations between  
9 noncertificated employee organizations and the Board of Education in Prince  
10 George's County.

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
12 Article - Education  
13 Section 6-510(b)  
14 Annotated Code of Maryland  
15 (1992 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Education**

19 6-510.

20 (b) (1) On request, a public school employer or at least two of its designated  
21 representatives shall meet and negotiate with at least two representatives of the employee  
22 organization that is designated as the exclusive negotiating agent for the public school  
23 employees in a unit of the county on all matters that relate to salaries, wages, hours, and  
24 other working conditions.

25 (2) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, MATTERS THAT RELATE TO  
26 WORKING CONDITIONS UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION INCLUDE  
27 MATTERS THAT RELATE TO THE DISCIPLINE OR DISCHARGE OF AN EMPLOYEE.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
29 July 1, 1996.
