16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 Article - Education

19 6-510.

20 (b) (1) On request, a public school employer or at least two of its designated 21 representatives shall meet and negotiate with at least two representatives of the employee 22 organization that is designated as the exclusive negotiating agent for the public school 23 employees in a unit of the county on all matters that relate to salaries, wages, hours, and 24 other working conditions.

(2) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, MATTERS THAT RELATE TO
WORKING CONDITIONS UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION INCLUDE
MATTERS THAT RELATE TO THE DISCIPLINE OR DISCHARGE OF AN EMPLOYEE.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 29 July 1, 1996.
