- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 **Article Education**

- 21 (G) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, FOR FISCAL
- 22 YEARS 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002, AND 2003, THE STATE SHALL ALLOCATE TO THEBOARD
- 23 OF EDUCATION OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE
- 24 REDUCTION IN STATE AID FOR BASIC CURRENT EXPENSES FOR EDUCATION TO
- 25 PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY RESULTING FROM THE ANNEXATION OF THE CITY OF
- 26 TAKOMA PARK TO MONTGOMERY COUNTY.
- 27 (2) THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY SHALL USE
- 28 THE ALLOCATED FUNDS FOR THE ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR AND

- 2 5-202(g) of the Education Article may not be used to supplant school construction funds
- 3 that the Montgomery County Public Schools otherwise would receive under§ 5-301 of the
- 4 Education Article.
- 5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 1996.
