- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 15 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- 17 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a person may not furnish
- 18 any alcoholic beverage to another person if:
- 19 (1) The person furnishing the beverage knows that the person isunder 21
- 20 years of age; and
- 21 (2) (I) The alcoholic beverage is furnished for the purpose of
- 22 consumption by the person under 21 years of age; OR
- 23 (II) THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE IS PLACED IN THE POSSESSION OF
- 24 OR UNDER THE CONTROL OF A PERSON WHO IS UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE.
- 25 (b) The prohibition in subsection (a) of this section does not applyif the
- 26 individual furnishing the alcoholic beverage and the individual to whomthe beverage is
- 27 served:
- 28 (1) Are members of the same immediate family, and the beverage is
- 29 furnished and consumed in a private residence; or

- 1 (2) Are participants in a religious ceremony.
- 2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 3 June 1, 1996.
