A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Buildings - Pictures of Abducted Children**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of General Services to reserve space in all
4 State buildings for the purpose of displaying pictures of certain abducted children;
5 and generally relating to pictures of abducted children and State buildings.

7 Article - State Finance and Procurement
8 Section 4-209
9 Annotated Code of Maryland
10 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

14 4-209.

15 THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES SHALL RESERVE A REASONABLE
16 AMOUNT OF SPACE IN ALL STATE BUILDINGS SO THAT ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT
17 AGENCY OR STATE RECOGNIZED NONPROFIT ADVOCACY GROUP FOR ABDUCTED
18 CHILDREN CAN DISPLAY THE PICTURE OF A CHILD ABDUCTED IN A
19 NONCUSTODY-RELATED ABDUCTION IN THE RESERVED SPACE.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 1996.
