SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Estates and Trusts 13

14 2-109.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a judge of the court may 15 16 not act as an attorney at law in a civil or criminal matter during a term of office.

17 (b) This section does not apply:

18 (1) In Harford County;

19 (2) In Montgomery County;

20 (3) In Baltimore City, to a judge of the Court while practicinglaw before 21 any court of the State except an orphans' court; or

- (4) In Prince George's [and], Calvert, AND ANNE ARUNDEL Counties, to a 22 23 judge of the Court while practicing law in connection with a case that is:
- 24 (i) Outside the jurisdiction of orphans' court; and
- 25 (ii) Unrelated to the administration of an estate or guardianship.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 27 October 1, 1996.
