5 FOR the purpose of altering the number of certain alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince
6 George's County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Prince George's
7 County.

9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
10 Section 9-217(b)(2), (11), and (12)
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (1994 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 9-217.

17 (b) The number of licenses of each class of alcoholic beverage licenses may not
18 exceed the following maximum amounts:

- 19 (2) Beer license, Class B.....[17] 21
- 20 (11) Beer, wine and liquor license, Class A.....[142] 144
- 21 (12) Beer, wine and liquor license, Class B.....[164] 167

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 1996.
