	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 6-201(r)(13) of Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 5-201(r)(4).

8 9	(r) (4) (i) There is a Class [B-Stadium] B-BW-STADIUM beer and light wine license.
