BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages 16 17 SUBTITLE 9. REVITALIZATION DISTRICTS. 18 8-901. 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "DISTRICT" MEANS: 20 (1) A DESIGNATED MARYLAND MAIN STREET WITH A LOCAL 21 MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY;

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1	(2) A DESIGNATED REVITALIZATION AREA; OR
2	(3) AN AREA WITH A REVITALIZATION PLAN THAT HAS BEEN ADOPTED LOCALLY.
4	(B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.
5	(C) THERE IS A CLASS B-RD LICENSE.
6 7	(D) (1) A CLASS B-RD (REVITALIZATION DISTRICT) LICENSE SHALL BE ISSUED BY THE OFFICE WHERE CLASS B LICENSES ARE ISSUED IN THE COUNTY.
	(2) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO KEEP FOR SALE AND SELL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR AT RETAIL IN ANY PREMISES LICENSED FOR CLASS B-RD SALES.
11	(3) ONLY ON-SALE CONSUMPTION IS PERMITTED.
12	(E) $\frac{\text{(1)}}{\text{THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS }} $200 $600$ .
13 14	(2) THE FEE SHALL BE PAID BEFORE ANY LICENSE IS ISSUED AND THE FEE SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AS PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE.
17	(3) PROCEEDS FROM THE FEE SHALL BE PLACED BY THE LOCAL MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY IN A FUND WHICH SHALL BE USED TO CONTINUE THE REVITALIZATION EFFORT IN THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH THE CLASS B-RD LICENSEE IS LOCATED.
