17	2. owned in fee by that land trust; and
18 19	3. subject to a letter of intent, agreement, or option agreement for the resale of the property to a government agency; OR
20	(III) OWNED BY THE POTOMAC CONSERVANCY.
21 22	(3) "Land trust" means a qualified conservation organization asdefined in § 3-2A-01 of the Natural Resources Article.
	(b) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the governing body of a county or municipal corporation may grant, by law, a property tax credit against the county or municipal corporation property tax imposed on conservation land that is used:
