3 FOR the purpose of waiving certain local primary and secondary education funding
4 requirements for Wicomico County for a certain fiscal year; providing for the
5 effective date of this Act; and generally relating to a waiver of certain local primary
6 and secondary education funding requirements for Wicomico County for a certain
7 fiscal year.

8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
9 MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, for Fiscal Year 1996
10 only, Wicomico County is not required to comply with the maintenance of effort
11 provisions of § 5-202(b)(3)(ii) of the Education Article in order to be eligible to receive
12 the State share of basic current expenses as provided in § 5-202(b) of the Education
13 Article. ~~For Fiscal Year 1997, the required level of appropriation by the governing body~~
14 ~~of Wicomico County under § 5-202(b)(3) of the Education Article shall be calculated~~
15 ~~based on the local appropriation for Fiscal Year 1995 or Fiscal Year 1996, whichever is~~
16 ~~greater.~~

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 June 1, 1996.
