# A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### 2 School Buses - Placement of Education-Related Public Service Messages

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the county boards of education to place or allow the

- 4 placement of public service messages related to education in the interior of school
- 5 buses; requiring the State Superintendent of Schools, in consultation with the
- 6 Administrator of the Motor Vehicle Administration, to adopt regulations
- 7 establishing certain guidelines and standards regarding the messagesplaced in
- 8 school buses; prohibiting the placement of signs in the interior of a school bus under
- 9 certain circumstances; authorizing the county boards to establish and charge fees
- 10 for the placement of public service messages in school buses and to use the fees for
- 11 education purposes; authorizing the county boards to donate space inschool buses
- 12 under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the placementof public
- 13 service messages within school buses.

# 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 21 Article - Education

22 7-609.

(A) A COUNTY BOARD MAY PLACE OR ALLOW THE PLACEMENT OF
EDUCATION-RELATED PUBLIC SERVICE MESSAGES IN THE INTERIOR OF ANY
SCHOOL BUS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD IN ACCORDANCE
WITH THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION.

27 (B) (1) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE
28 ADMINISTRATOR OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION, SHALL ADOPT
29 REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING:

(I) GUIDELINES AND STANDARDS REGARDING THE TYPES OF
 MESSAGES THAT ARE APPROPRIATE FOR DISPLAY WITHIN A SCHOOL BUS THAT IS
 USED PRIMARILY FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF CHILDREN; AND

4 (II) SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE SIZE, APPEARANCE, AND 5 PLACEMENT OF THE MESSAGES THAT ARE PERMITTED.

6 (2) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL
7 PROHIBIT THE PLACEMENT OF ANY SIGN WITHIN A SCHOOL BUS THAT WOULD
8 REDUCE OR OBSCURE THE VISIBILITY OF A SIGN REQUIRED UNDER ANY OTHER
9 PROVISION OF LAW TO BE PLACED WITHIN A SCHOOL BUS.

10 (C) (1) A COUNTY BOARD MAY ESTABLISH AND CHARGE A FEE TO BE PAID 11 BY A PERSON SEEKING TO PLACE A PUBLIC SERVICE MESSAGE IN A SCHOOL BUS.

(2) THE FEES PAID TO THE COUNTY BOARD UNDER THIS SECTION
 SHALL BE RETAINED AND USED BY THE COUNTY BOARD FOR ANY
 EDUCATION-RELATED PURPOSE AUTHORIZED BY LAW.

(3) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION PROHIBITS A COUNTY BOARD FROM
 OFFERING TO NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS OR GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES,
 WITHOUT CHARGE, SPACE WITHIN SCHOOL BUSES FOR THE PLACEMENT OF
 EDUCATION-RELATED PUBLIC SERVICE MESSAGES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 1996.

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
