## 1 AN ACT concerning

2	State Employee and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program - Reasonable
3	Reimbursement

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Budget and Fiscal Planning to include

- 5 certain criteria in certain procurement documents relating to the State Employee
- 6 and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program to ensure that certain
- 7 reimbursement levels provided to providers of services under the Program are
- 8 reasonable and competitive, and ensure that providers are adequatelycompensated
- 9 for services, expenses and a fair profit.

10 BY adding to

- 11 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 12 Section 8-106.1
- 13 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 14 (1994 Volume and 1995 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 17 Article - State Personnel and Pensions

18 8-106.1.

IN THE FACTORS INCLUDED IN A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS OR IN
SPECIFICATIONS FOR AN INVITATION FOR BIDS FOR ANY BENEFITS PROVIDED
UNDER THE PROGRAM, THE SECRETARY SHALL INCLUDE CRITERIA THAT ASSURES
THAT REIMBURSEMENT LEVELS PROVIDED TO ANY PROVIDERS OF SERVICES BY
THE RESPONSIBLE BIDDER OR OFFEROR AWARDED A CONTRACT UNDER THE
PROGRAM ARE REASONABLE AND COMPETITIVE, AND ENSURE THAT PROVIDERS
ARE ADEQUATELY COMPENSATED FOR SERVICES, EXPENSES AND A FAIR PROFIT.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 27 October 1, 1996.
