## A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### 2 Frederick County - State's Attorney - Criminal Investigators

3 FOR the purpose of providing that a criminal investigator appointed by the Frederick

- 4 County State's Attorney is subject to certain regulations and criteria established by
- 5 the State's Attorney; allowing the State's Attorney to designate thecriminal
- 6 investigator as a peace officer if the criminal investigator meets certain
- 7 requirements; providing certain authorities, duties, and limitationsfor a criminal
- 8 investigator who is designated as a peace officer; and generally relating to criminal
- 9 investigators in Frederick County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 Article 10 Legal Officials

19 (k) (1) In Frederick County, the State's Attorney's annual salary is\$52,000.

20 (2) The State's Attorney may appoint a member of the bar of Frederick 21 County as deputy State's Attorney, to serve at the pleasure of the State's Attorney. The 22 deputy State's Attorney's annual salary shall be set by the State's Attorney, subject to the 23 approval of the County Commissioners. Under the direction of the State's Attorney, the 24 deputy State's Attorney shall present cases to the grand jury and perform such other acts 25 and duties in relation to the grand jury and in the operation of the office as are necessary 26 and proper.

27 (3) The State's Attorney and deputy State's Attorney may not engage in the28 private practice of law.

(4) The Board of County Commissioners shall provide an office in thecourthouse for the State's Attorney. The Board shall pay the expenses of the office,

	including general operating expenses, cost of equipment, and the reasonable salary of a stenographer to be appointed by the State's Attorney.
5 6 7 8 9	(5) The State's Attorney may appoint the number of full or part-time assistant State's Attorneys and other staff personnel as may be approved by the County Commissioners. All such appointees shall serve at the State's Attorney's pleasure. The salaries and compensation of such persons shall be as approved by the County Commissioners. The assistant State's Attorneys shall have the same legal powers as the State's Attorney to present cases to the grand jury and perform such other acts and duties in relation to the grand jury and in the operations of the office as are necessary and proper.

29	(II) IF A CRIMINAL INVESTIGATOR MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF ARTICLE 41, § 4-201 OF THE CODE RELATING TO THE SELECTION AND TRAINING STANDARDS OF THE POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION, THE STATE'S ATTORNEY MAY DESIGNATE THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATOR AS A PEACE OFFICER.

34 35	1. IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 27, §§727 THROUGH 734D OF THE CODE; AND
	2. IN ADDITION TO THE AUTHORITY, DUTIES, AND LIMITATIONS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY OF A PEACE OFFICER IN FREDERICK COUNTY, INCLUDING

4 ANY CIRCUIT COURT OR THE DISTRICT COURT IN FREDERICK COUNTY; AND

5 C. POSSESS AND CARRY A FIREARM, INCLUDING A 6 HANDGUN, OR OTHER WEAPON REQUIRED BY, THE STATE'S ATTORNEY.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 July 1, 1996.
