- 18 (A) Except for a law enforcement officer in the line of duty OR AS PROVIDED IN
- 19 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, a person may not discharge a firearm:
- 20 (1) Within 150 yards of a building which can be used as a residence, whether
- 21 occupied or vacant; or
- 22 (2) On any property owned by another person or by Calvert County without
- 23 evidence of permission on his person.
- 24 (B) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY, BY ORDINANCE, AUTHORIZE A
- 25 BONA FIDE VETERANS' ORGANIZATION TO CONDUCT, FOR FUND-RAISING
- 26 PURPOSES, AN ORGANIZED SHOOTING EVENT THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE
- 27 RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A)(1) OR (2) OR BOTH, OF THIS SECTION.
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 29 October 1, 1996.
