1 AN ACT concerning

2 Counties - Computer Software Programs - Sale, Lease, or Licensing

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a county to sell, lease, or license to the public any

- 4 computer software program that is produced or developed by or for the county in
- 5 the normal course of its operations; permitting a county to adopt a price structure
- 6 for a computer software program based on certain factors; defining acertain term;
- 7 and generally relating to the sale, lease, or licensing of computer software programs
- 8 by counties.

- 10 Article 24 Political Subdivisions Miscellaneous Provisions
- 11 Section 17-101 to be under the new title "Title 17. Sale, Lease, or Licensing of
- 12 Computer Software Programs"

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions

18 TITLE 17. SALE, LEASE, OR LICENSING OF COMPUTER SOFTWARE
 19 PROGRAMS.

20 17-101.

21 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "COMPUTER SOFTWARE PROGRAM" MEANS A
22 SOFTWARE PROGRAM TO ACCESS DATA, OR TO IMPLEMENT A PROCESS USING
23 DATA, IN A COMPUTER SYSTEM.

24 (2) "COMPUTER SOFTWARE PROGRAM" DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY
25 COMPUTER SOFTWARE PROGRAM THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE
26 10, SUBTITLE 9 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

27 (B) (1) A COUNTY MAY SELL, LEASE, OR LICENSE TO THE PUBLIC, OR
28 ENTER INTO A CONTRACT CONCERNING, ANY COMPUTER SOFTWARE PROGRAM
29 THAT IS PRODUCED OR DEVELOPED BY OR FOR THE COUNTY IN THE NORMAL

1 COURSE OF ITS OPERATIONS, INCLUDING PATENTS, TRADEMARKS, AND 2 COPYRIGHTS.

3 (2) A COUNTY MAY ADOPT A PRICE STRUCTURE FOR A COMPUTER
4 SOFTWARE PROGRAM BASED ON ANY FACTORS THAT THE COUNTY CONSIDERS
5 RELEVANT, INCLUDING:

6 (I) THE COSTS OF CREATING, DEVELOPING, REPRODUCING, AND 7 DELIVERING THE COMPUTER SOFTWARE PROGRAM;

8 (II) OVERHEAD AND LABOR COSTS; AND

9 (III) THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE COMPUTER SOFTWARE 10 PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 October 1, 1996.
