## 2 Health Occupations - Pharmacies

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a person to hold a pharmacy permit issued by the Maryland
- 4 State Board of Pharmacy before the person dispenses prescription drugs or devices
- 5 to residents of this State; prohibiting a person from dispensing prescription drugs or
- 6 devices to residents of this State unless the person holds a pharmacy permit;
- 7 providing that a person who violates this Act is guilty of a misdemeanor and is
- 8 subject to certain penalties; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to
- 9 the regulation of pharmacies.

- 16 WHEREAS, An increasing number of consumers in this State have prescriptions
- 17 filled through the mail by pharmacies located outside of this State; and
- WHEREAS, The pharmacies filling these prescriptions are not required to have a
- 19 permit issued by the Maryland State Board of Pharmacy and their activities are not
- 20 subject to regulation by this State; and
- 21 WHEREAS, This State has developed a comprehensive system of laws to regulate
- 22 the activities of persons that provide pharmaceutical services and products to residents of
- 23 this State in order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of residents of this
- 24 State; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Consumers in this State, whether they receive prescription drugs from
- 26 a pharmacy located in this State or in another state, are entitled to the protection of these
- 27 laws; now, therefore,
- 28 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 29 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 1 **Article - Health Occupations** 2 12-101. (i) "Pharmacy permit" means a permit issued by the Board to establish and 3 4 operate a pharmacy OR TO DISPENSE PRESCRIPTION DRUGS OR DEVICES TO 5 RESIDENTS OF THIS STATE. 6 12-401. (a) A person shall hold a pharmacy permit issued by the Board beforethe person 7 8 may: 9 (1) [establish] ESTABLISH or operate a pharmacy in this State; OR (2) DISPENSE PRESCRIPTION DRUGS OR DEVICES TO ANY RESIDENT OF 10 11 THIS STATE. 12 (b) A separate pharmacy permit is required for each pharmacy that a person 13 establishes or operates. 14 12-703. A person may not establish or operate a pharmacy in this State, OR DISPENSE 15 16 PRESCRIPTION DRUGS OR DEVICES TO ANY RESIDENT OF THIS STATE, unless the 17 person holds a pharmacy permit issued by the Board. 18 12-707. 19 (b) A person who violates any provision of the following sections of this title is 20 guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or 21 imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both: 22 (1) § 12-601 ("Manufacturing and packaging"); (2) § 12-602 ("Distribution permits"); 23 (3) § 12-701 ("Practicing pharmacy without license"); 24 25 (4) § 12-702 ("License obtained by false representation"); (5) § 12-703 ("Operating a pharmacy OR DISPENSING DRUGS without 26 27 permit"); and 28 (6) § 12-704 ("Misrepresentations").
