## 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City Life Museums

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$500,000
- 4 \$300,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the
- 5 Baltimore City Life Museums, Inc. for certain acquisition, development, or
- 6 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to
- 7 a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; requiring a
- 8 historic easement; and providing generally for the issuance and saleof bonds
- 9 evidencing the loan.
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore City
- 14 Life Museums Loan of 1996 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$500,000
- 15 \$300,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordancewith Section
- 16 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State
- 17 general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and
- 18 issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State
- 19 Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan maybe sold as a
- 21 single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under §
- 22 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 23 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and
- 24 first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the
- 25 bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on
- 26 the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works,

- 1 for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects'and engineers' fees:
- 2 as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Baltimore City Life Museums, Inc. (referred to
- 3 hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the repair, renovation, and equipping of a
- 4 warehouse to serve as a storage and management facility for the historical collections of
- 5 the City Life Museums and to complete the construction of a paved courtyard, which shall
- 6 be the public entrance to five museums and historic sites.
- 7 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate 8 and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and when due 9 and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of 10 issuance of the bonds.
- 11 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 12 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching
- 13 fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly or
- 14 indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of
- 15 the fund may consist of real property or in kind contributions. The fund may consist of
- 16 funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the
- 17 amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 18 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The
- 19 grantee has until June 1, 1998, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public
- 20 Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the
- 21 Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer,
- 22 and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended
- 23 for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of
- 24 the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no
- 25 further effect.
- 26 (6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey to
- 27 the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of its
- 28 interest:
- 29 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- 30 and
- 31 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 32 structures.
- 33 (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust
- 34 and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.
- 35 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 36 June 1, 1996.
