- 4 FOR the purpose of limiting, to the rate of inflation for the previous calendar year, the
- 5 amount of the annual increase in tuition and mandatory fees that maybe charged

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Education
- 16 13-303.
- 17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 18 INDICATED.
- 19 (2) "ACADEMIC YEAR" MEANS THE PERIOD COMMENCING WITH THE
- 20 FALL SEMESTER AND CONTINUING THROUGH THE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING
- 21 SUMMER SESSION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND COLLEGE PARK.
- 22 (3) "CONSUMER PRICE INDEX" MEANS THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX
- 23 (ALL URBAN CONSUMERS UNITED STATES CITY AVERAGE ALL ITEMS) FOR THE
- 24 YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31 AS PUBLISHED BY THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR
- 25 BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS.
- 26 (B) THE BOARD OF REGENTS MAY NOT APPROVE, AND THE UNIVERSITY OF
- 27 MARYLAND COLLEGE PARK MAY NOT IMPOSE, AN INCREASE IN THE TUITION AND
- 28 MANDATORY FEES CHARGED FOR AN ACADEMIC YEAR TO A RESIDENT
- 29 UNDERGRADUATE OR GRADUATE STUDENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND
