5 the membership of the County Board; establishing certain qualifications and terms

6 for members; authorizing the State Board to remove members of the County Board

7 under certain circumstances; providing for the annual compensation of County

8 Board members; requiring the County Board to hold a public meeting before taking

9 action; authorizing certain executive sessions; requiring the CountyBoard to hold

10 its annual meeting after a certain date; <u>making special provisions for the election of</u>

11 <u>members of the County Board in 1996;</u> and generally relating to the St. Mary's

LONGER A RESIDENT AND A REGISTERED VOTER OF ST. MARY'S COUNTY MAY NOT
CONTINUE AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD.

29 (II) A CANDIDATE WHO FILES TO REPRESENT ONE OF THE
30 COMMISSIONER ELECTION DISTRICTS MUST BE A RESIDENT OF THAT ELECTION

(2) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY 1 2 BOARD AT THE TIME OF FILING IS INELIGIBLE TO BE A CANDIDATE. 3 (II) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS AN IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER, 4 INCLUDING A SPOUSE, SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY BOARD MAY 5 NOT SERVE AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD. 6 (E) (1) THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY BOARD CONSISTS OF FIVE VOTING 7 MEMBERS WHO SHALL BE ELECTED AS FOLLOWS: 8 (I) ONE MEMBER SHALL BE ELECTED FROM THE COUNTY AT 9 LARGE: AND 10 (II) ONE MEMBER SHALL BE ELECTED FROM EACH OF THE FOUR 11 COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS. (2) VOTING MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE ELECTED: 12 13 (I) AT A GENERAL ELECTION AS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION; 14 AND 15 (II) ON A GENERAL COUNTYWIDE TICKET. 16 (3) MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD ELECTED IN THE 1996 GENERAL 17 ELECTION FROM COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS ONE AND THREE SHALL SERVE FOR AN 18 INITIAL TERM OF 2 YEARS. AN ELECTION SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN 1998 AND EVERY 19 4 YEARS THEREAFTER. (4) MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD ELECTED IN THE 1996 GENERAL 20 21 ELECTION FROM COMMISSIONER ELECTION DISTRICTS TWO AND FOUR AND FROM 22 THE COUNTY AT LARGE SHALL SERVE FOR AN INITIAL TERM OF 4 YEARS. AN 23 ELECTION SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN 2000 AND EVERY 4 YEARS THEREAFTER. (5) EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED IN THIS SECTION. ELECTIONS SHALL BE 24 25 CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 33, SUBTITLE 32 OF THE ANNOTATED 26 CODE OF MARYLAND. (F) (1) THE STUDENT MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE ELECTED 27 28 BY QUALIFIED STUDENTS OF THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM. THE 29 STUDENT MEMBER SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE COUNTY BOARD. 30 (2) THE VOTING MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL: 31 (I) DETERMINE WHICH STUDENTS IN THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY 32 PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM MAY ELECT THE STUDENT MEMBER OF THE COUNTY 33 BOARD: AND (II) DEVELOP NOMINATION AND ELECTION PROCEDURES 34 35 GOVERNING THE ELECTION OF THE STUDENT MEMBER. (G) (1) EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED IN THIS SECTION, AN ELECTED MEMBER 36 37 SHALL SERVE FOR A TERM OF 4 YEARS. THE TERM OF EACH MEMBER SHALL 38 COMMENCE ON THE FIRST MONDAY IN DECEMBER AFTER THE MEMBER'S ELECTION 39 AND SHALL CONTINUE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIES.

1 (2) THE TERM OF THE STUDENT MEMBER SHALL COMMENCE ON THE 2 FIRST MONDAY IN JULY AND CONTINUE FOR 1 YEAR.

3 (3) IF A VACANCY OCCURS ON THE COUNTY BOARD, THE BOARD ST.
 4 MARY'S BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL APPOINT A QUALIFIED
 5 INDIVIDUAL TO SERVE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM AND UNTIL A
 6 SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIES.

7 (H) (1) THE STATE BOARD MAY REMOVE A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY8 BOARD FOR:

9 (I) IMMORALITY;

10 (II) MISCONDUCT IN OFFICE;

11 (III) INCOMPETENCE; OR

12 (IV) WILLFUL NEGLECT OF DUTY.

13 (2) BEFORE REMOVING A MEMBER, THE STATE BOARD SHALL SEND
14 THE MEMBER A NOTICE, BY REGISTERED MAIL, RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED,
15 THAT SPECIFIES THE CHARGES AGAINST THE MEMBER.

(3) (I) WITHIN 15 DAYS FROM THE DATE THE STATE BOARD SENDS
THE NOTICE, THE MEMBER MAY REQUEST A PUBLIC HEARING. THE MEMBER SHALL
SEND THIS REQUEST TO THE <u>COUNTY</u> BOARD BY REGISTERED MAIL, RETURN
RECEIPT REQUESTED.

(II) IF THE MEMBER REQUESTS A HEARING, THE STATE BOARD
SHALL CONDUCT A HEARING PROMPTLY, BUT NOT BEFORE THE 11TH DAY FROM
THE DATE THE STATE BOARD SENT NOTICE TO THE MEMBER.

23 (III) THE MEMBER SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO A PUBLIC HEARING24 AND TO REPRESENTATION BY COUNSEL AT THE HEARING.

25 (4) A MEMBER REMOVED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION HAS THE RIGHT TO

The filing deadline for 36 candidates for election in November 1996 shall be 5:00 p.m. on August 5, 1996. The St.
