11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - State Government**

14 15-507.

15 Except in the discharge of an official duty, an official [or], employee, FORMER
16 OFFICIAL, OR FORMER EMPLOYEE may not disclose or use confidential information
17 acquired by reason of the official's or employee's public position and not available to the
18 public:

19 (1) for personal economic benefit; or

20 (2) for the economic benefit of another.
