A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County - Appointment of Members to the Board of Education**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to appoint members of the Anne Arundel  
4 County Board of Education from a list of a certain number of nominees submitted  
5 by the School Board Nominating Convention of Anne Arundel County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article - Education  
8 Section 3-110  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (1992 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Education**

14 3-110.

15 (a) The Anne Arundel County Board consists of 8 members who shall be  
16 appointed as follows:

17 (1) 3 from the County at large;

18 (2) 1 each from Legislative Districts 31, 32, and 33;

19 (3) 1 from Legislative District 27B (Anne Arundel County Election District  
20 7; Precincts 1 and 2) or District 30; and

21 (4) 1 student member.

22 (B) EXCEPT FOR THE STUDENT MEMBER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A  
23 MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD FROM A LIST OF THREE NOMINEES SUBMITTED TO  
24 THE GOVERNOR BY THE SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING CONVENTION OF ANNE  
25 ARUNDEL COUNTY.

26 [(b)] (C) (1) The student member shall:

27 (i) Be a regularly enrolled senior year student of good character and  
28 in good standing in an Anne Arundel County public high school;

1 (ii) Be selected in the student's junior year by a method selected by the  
2 Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils of Anne Arundel County; and

3 (iii) 1. Serve a term of 1 year; and

4 2. Continue to serve after graduation and until a successor is  
5 appointed and qualifies.

6 (2) If a vacancy in the position of the student member occurs during the  
7 term of the student member, the Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils  
8 shall:

9 (i) Conduct a special election at its next general meeting; and

10 (ii) By utilizing the same method that it used to select the previous  
11 student member of the Board, select another student member to fill the vacancy.

12 [(c)] (D) A Board member who does not maintain the residency qualification  
13 shall be replaced as a member.

14 [(d)] (E) If the boundary line of a legislative district changes, an incumbent  
15 member of the County Board who, because of the change, no longer resides in the  
16 legislative district from which the member was appointed may complete the term.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
18 October 1, 1996.
