CHAPTER ____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Melwood - Horticultural Training

- 3 Center Facilities
- 4 [TAG ftpo]FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$533,250
- 5 not to exceed \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Boardof Directors
- 6 of the Melwood Horticultural Training Center, Inc. for certain acquisition,
- 7 development, or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of theloan
- 8 proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching
- 9 fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the 10 loan.
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That:
- 13 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince George's
- 15 County Melwood Horticultural Training Center Facilities Loan of 1996 in the total
- 16 principal amount of \$533,250 a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$200,000
- 17 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below.
- 18 This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation
- 19 bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 20 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 21 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 22 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan maybe sold as a
- 23 single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under §
- 24 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 25 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and
- 26 first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the

- 1 bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on
- 2 the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works,
- 3 for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects'and engineers' fees:
- 4 as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Melwood Horticultural Training Center, Inc.
- 5 (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning, design, construction,
- 6 and capital equipping of a new building, together with parking facilities, and other site
- 7 improvements, for use as a training facility for developmentally disabled individuals, to be
- 8 located in Prince George's County.
- 9 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate
- 10 and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and when due
- 11 and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of
- 12 issuance of the bonds.
- 13 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 14 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching
- 15 fund of \$177,750. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly
- 16 or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part
- 17 of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to
- 18 the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching
- 19 fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works
- 20 shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1,
- 21 1998, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund
- 22 will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
- 23 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
- 24 equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in
- 25 this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified
- 26 by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 June 1, 1996.
