1 2	(E) (1) THE CATCH LIMIT FOR A HOLDER OF A NONCOMMERCIAL CRABBING LICENSE IS:
3	(I) 1 BUSHEL DAILY; OR
4 5	(II) IF THERE ARE TWO OR MORE HOLDERS OF NONCOMMERCIAL CRABBING LICENSES ON A BOAT, 2 BUSHELS DAILY PER BOAT.
8	(2) HOLDERS OF NONCOMMERCIAL CRABBING LICENSES ATTEMPTING TO CATCH OR CATCHING CRABS FROM A BOAT, REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF LICENSE HOLDERS ABOARD, MAY NOT USE FROM ONE BOAT MORE THAN A TOTAL OF:
10	(I) 25 COLLAPSIBLE CRAB TRAPS OR RINGS; AND
11	(II) TWO 1,000-FOOT TROTLINES.

	(G) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MAY CATCH OR ATTEMPT TO CATCH CRABS UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT OFFER TO SELL OR SELL CRABS THAT WERE CAUGHT FOR NONCOMMERCIAL OR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.
	(2) A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY BUY OR OFFER TO BUY CRABS FROM AN INDIVIDUAL WHO CAUGHT CRABS FOR NONCOMMERCIAL PURPOSES UNDER THIS SECTION.
21 22	(3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SUBSECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO:
23	(I) FOR FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500; AND
24 25	(II) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$500 AND NOT EXCEEDING \$2,000.
