- 16 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CHARLES COUNTY.
- 17 (B) A LICENSEE MAY SELL AND A PERSON MAY CONSUME ALCOHOLIC
- 18 BEVERAGES PERMITTED BY THE LICENSE ON THE GROUNDS OF ANY PRIVATELY
- 19 OWNED GOLF COURSE.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 October 1, 1996.
