- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Labor and Employment
- 17 9-736.
- 18 (b) (1) The Commission has continuing powers and jurisdiction over each claim
- 19 under this title.
- 20 (2) Subject to paragraph (3) of this subsection, the Commissionmay modify
- 21 any finding or order as the Commission considers justified.
- 22 (3) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, the Commission may
- 23 not modify an award unless the modification is applied for within 5 years after the last
- 24 compensation payment.
- 25 (4) PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A
- 26 CLAIMANT WHO HAS RECEIVED TEMPORARY TOTAL DISABILITY BENEFITS FROM
- 27 MAKING AN INITIAL APPLICATION FOR AND RECEIVING AN AWARD OF PERMANENT
- 28 PARTIAL DISABILITY BENEFITS MORE THAN 5 YEARS AFTER THE LAST
- 29 COMPENSATION PAYMENT OF TEMPORARY TOTAL DISABILITY BENEFITS.
