1 AN ACT concerning

2 Design Professional Boards - Reinstatement of Licenses - Fees

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering certain fees charged by the State Board of Architects, the State Board of Examiners of Landscape Architects, the State Board for Professional 4 Engineers, and the State Board for Professional Land Surveyors for licensees to 5 6 reinstate licenses; requiring certain licensees to pay certain renewal fees; requiring 7 the State Board of Examiners of Landscape Architects to reinstate certain licenses 8 under certain circumstances; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating 9 to the fees charged by the State Board of Architects, the State Board of Examiners 10 of Landscape Architects, the State Board for Professional Engineers, and the State 11 Board for Professional Land Surveyors for licensees to reinstate licenses.
