19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

4 (1) REVIEW TRANSPORTATION PLANS AND PROGRAMS PREPARED BY
5 THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND REGIONAL PLANNING AGENCIES AND
6 MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN
7 TRANSPORTATION AND PLANNED LAND USE; AND

8 (2) EVALUATE PROPOSED TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS AND
9 POLICIES TO ASSURE CONSISTENCY BETWEEN TRANSPORTATION INVESTMENTS

12 (I) THE OFFICE MAY PROVIDE ADVICE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS13 REGARDING THE IMPACT ON GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT OF:

14 (1) TRANSPORTATION COMPONENTS OF LOCAL PLANS;

15 (2) ASPECTS OF LOCAL LAND USE REGULATION AFFECTING16 TRANSPORTATION; AND

17 (3) LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS.

(F) AT THE EARLIEST PRACTICAL DATE BUT NO LATER THAN NOVEMBER 1
OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE PROPOSED CONSOLIDATED
TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM AND THE PROPOSED MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION
PLAN TO THE OFFICE OF PLANNING FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT ON PLANNING
ISSUES INCLUDING CONSISTENCY BETWEEN TRANSPORTATION INVESTMENTS AND
THE STATE ECONOMIC GROWTH, RESOURCE PROTECTION, AND PLANNING POLICY.
